SWIM CANADA REMS REGISTRATION FOR OFFICIALS:

Anyone wishing to participate in swim meets as a timer must first register as an official with Swim Canada using their REMS system. This process is completed *annually*.

The timer courses are online e-modules that you can access through the learning management system (LMS), inside your Swim Canada REMS account.

4 Steps to Follow:


2) Login to your newly created REMS account, and from there, click on "Login to LMS"

- 4) Once you have completed both e-modules, you may fill out the PPP reporting form: https://www.tritons.ca/ppp. You have earned 2 PPP, and are now permitted to sign up as a timer at time trials and swim meets.
